The Government of Spain, through its Ministry of Universities, is inviting relevant international scientists to constitute an "Interdisciplinary Assessment Board" to support a pilot interdisciplinary and cross-disciplinary research programme in Artificial Intelligence, within the framework of the European Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan -funded by the European Union- NextGenerationEU.

This is an innovative and highly relevant initiative within the "Spanish Artificial Intelligence Strategy", which seeks to promote a new approach to focus on interdisciplinary, creatively innovative and exploratory scientific projects, bringing together both humanities and social science disciplines, as well as Artificial Intelligence experts, in order to open up new research ideas that transcend, combine or simultaneously span several disciplines.

Who we are looking for

- We are directly inviting international researches who are not part of the Spanish system for the "Interdisciplinary Evaluation Board. The selection has been made on the basis of the scientific reputation
- We welcome researchers from all disciplines who understand and appreciate interdisciplinary research and who find it as an opportunity to be part of a novel interdisciplinary research initiative.

What you'll be doing

- Each reviewer will receive between one and a maximum of three proposals from the end of September to the end of October.
- An "evaluation guide" will be provided to assist the researchers in the review process.
- You will receive a remuneration fee of €130 for each evaluated proposal.
- As the evaluation will be using online platforms, there will be no requirement to travel or attend any
 meetings, so the engagement as an evaluator is limited to submitting the expert opinion in the evaluation
 of proposals.
- Proposals will be evaluated on the basis of "excellence, interdisciplinarity and originality" as the sole
 criterion, inspired in the Sinergy Grant call from the European Research Council (ERC).
